Campers must arrange to let in their visitors or service people in October.

Applications for Renewal of Season Sites:

If you're coming back next year, return the completed renewal form with your deposit and winter storage by Sunday September 18th. Winter storage fees apply if *anything other* than a deck or garden shed remains on your site. Special on-site winter storage rates only apply if you are returning next season, put a non-refundable deposit on their site for 2006 and pre-pay winter storage. Winter Storage costs \$30.00 per month if not pre-paid. This year's season rates will apply for 2006 if pre-paid with a post-dated cheque Dec.30, 2005. Campers not returning next season must have their site cleared by the end of the 2005 season. Winterizing Service is available through the park for \$57.50 including taxes. Remember Glenn needs access to all water taps inside your trailer as well as access to the water heater for winterizing so please make sure he has clear access to them and the necessary keys. Keys for winterizing must be properly labeled with your name & site number.
